## ***DREAMS COME TRUE AT SCUGOG SHOWCASE***

Imagine yourself spending a weekend in the company of 25 superb regional artists, discussing their working methods and taking home some of their unique artistic creations. Your golden opportunity to fulfill this dream comes to Port Perry on November 19 and 20 at the first annual Showcase of the Arts, a show and sale of fine art and fine craft. The exhibition at the Scugog Community Recreation Centre, 1655 Reach St., will feature jewelry, pottery, woven baskets, turned or carved wood, sculptures in stone, metal or glass, hand-woven linens, photography, paintings and more.

Marilyn Pearce, Mayor of the Township of Scugog, suggested the concept for this inaugural event at a meeting of the Scugog Council for the Arts (SCA) earlier this spring. "The arts and culture play a key role in the social and economic development of communities" states Mayor Pearce. "This one-of-a kind Art Show for Scugog is envisioned as a chance for local artists to showcase their work and for the community to connect and celebrate their creativity". Kent Farndale, a well-known supporter of the arts for many years, is very excited about Showcase and believes, "It will provide an excellent opportunity to view the outstanding works of the talented artists of our area".

The Township of Scugog and the Scugog Council for the Arts have partnered to present Showcase of the Arts. Proceeds will be used to foster all the arts in Scugog. The SCA agrees that such an event supports its mandate to facilitate collaborative relationships among artists, organizations, businesses and government. "This exhibition will enhance the vibrancy of the arts and community life," says show convener Karen Richardson, "as well as provide sales and networking opportunities for our artists and some funding for our newly formed arts council. Everybody wins".

All members of the public are welcome to attend Showcase of the Arts: first time buyers, art enthusiasts and seasoned collectors. Day passes are \$3 for general admission and \$2 for SCA members. Children 14 and under can attend for free when accompanied by an adult. Show hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Port Perry's Hospital Auxiliary will provide a lunch and snack service. Come, enjoy, learn and buy!

Each ticket includes a weekend Showcase pass plus musical entertainment, refreshments and an opportunity to win a door prize! **LOCAL ARTIST WINS INTERNATIONAL AWARD**

Port Perry artist and SCA member Karen Richardson was surprised and thrilled this summer to hear she had been chosen as a Finalist in an art competition sponsored by International Artist magazine. She received the news of her win from an artist friend who recognized Karen's watercolour painting pictured on a full page in the June/July issue. Karen had not yet read her copy of the magazine when her friend phoned with congratulations. International Artist, described as "the magazine for artists by artists from around the world", is published in Australia six times each year and distributed to over 100,000 artists worldwide. Karen has subscribed to the magazine for a few years and finally last winter entered one of their competitions for the first time. She sent a slide of her painting 'Rivers in Time' in the 'Seascapes, Rivers and Lakes' Art Prize Challenge and thought no more about it until her friend called a few months later with the happy news. The large watercolour painting portrays a waterfall running between huge slabs of bedrock into a stream below, and was inspired by the dramatic scenery of the Georgian Bay area.

This spring, before Karen learned of the International Artist win, she entered the same painting in the Whitby Station Gallery's annual art competition. This year the theme was 'The Great Canadian Landscape', as part of a province-wide festival of events celebrating the 85<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first exhibition of The Group of Seven. Karen felt 'Rivers in Time' would be an appropriate entry. Imagine her delight when she was awarded a first place certificate in the adult category and a cash prize for her painting! 'Rivers in Time' will be displayed in Karen's next art exhibition, Showcase of the Arts, November 18 to 20 in Port Perry.
